Another significant draw to the area is the 1.2 million sq. foot Altamonte Mall with it's unique collection of department stores, niche boutiques, award winning restaurants, and AMC theatre.

Cranes Roost Park is at the heart of Uptown Altamonte circling Cranes Roost Lake with 1 mile of continuous walkways. Within the 45-acre park is a European-styled Plaza which includes choreographed fountain shows and the Eddie Rose Amphitheater with stadium styled seating



and a one-of-a-kind floating stage.
